resources, but it is one that must never be neglected. We owe this to the men and women who sacrifice so much to protect our freedoms, our way of life, and help bring peace to the world. We are so very grateful for your encouragement and support to this mission work to those of the Armed Forces.

Some of our work in 2017 included processing over 250 locator requests for Soldiers, Marines, Airmen, and Sailors going to training and overseas bases. The first AMEN marriage workshop was held in early June at the Groton Church of

Christ serving the New London Submarine Base and the U.S. Coast Guard Academy in Connecticut. This past summer conducted we comprehensive review of our Key Man roster resulting in numerous changes highlighting areas where we need to recruit contacts. I am happy to report that we have recruited 33 new Key Men and Women some of whom are listed in this newsletter. were able to network with missionary contacts for soldiers deployed to Poland and Romania. We aided military members to begin worship services at Camp Arifian,

Kuwait; Joint Base Djibouti, Africa; and NS Rota, Spain. Church of Christ Military Ministries Discuss Spiritual Care

On 4 March 2017, the three military ministries associated with the Church of Christ came together at the invitation of the Bear Valley Church in Denver CO to pray, discuss, and determine how to be of greater service to military brethren around the world. Representing Military Outreach of the Bear Valley Institute was Dick Brant, Dave Chamberlain, and John Phillis. Military Outreach and Encouragement (M.O.R.E.) of the Mayfair Church in Huntsville AL was represented by Ed Linebaugh and Mel Caraway. Dennis Saucier represented the AMEN Ministry of the Manchester CT Church. The half day conference included introductions of the ministry leaders, descriptions of the distinct services each ministry offers to military Christians, and how to respond to the current environment facing the U.S. Armed Forces like the deployment of the 3rd Brigade Combat Team to Eastern Europe. *Military Outreach* provides teachers or teaching teams by invitation to any congregation

worldwide from a few days to a few months using the training program taught in their school of preaching. Military Outreach and Encouragement seeks to build up military Christians by sending them cards, letters, morale packages, distributing Biblical materials and praying for the troops and their families. AMEN Ministry focuses on connecting military Christians with local churches stateside, overseas, onboard naval vessels and at deployed locations. It is expanding its services by offering spiritual growth workshops and retreats. Other items discussed included supporting soldiers deployed to Eastern Europe; the possibility of offering a spiritual retreat for Christians assigned to Pacific Rim installations; supporting the endorsement process of the Fairfax VA Church for chaplains and Distinctive Faith Group Leaders; and ways to market the respective military ministries. All attending agreed to commit themselves to meeting the spiritual needs of today's military community.
