TRANSFORMATION

In his letter to the church in Rome the apostle Paul instructed believers to no longer conform to the world but be transformed by the renewing of his or her mind which is their spiritual worship (Romans 12:1-2). The goal of such transformation is to be able to understand and follow the will of God. In other words, each disciple should be prepared for what is to come which is the ultimate reign of Jesus Christ, Lord and Savior. In conforming our minds to the mind of Christ our bodies, or actions, become in Paul's words a

living sacrifice holy and pleasing to God (Romans 12:1; 1 Corinthians 2:12-16). Such transformation builds resilience through the confidence knowing we are in harmony with God and experiencing the fulness of Christ's redemption. This is the faith that leads to the hope of eternal life (see Hebrews 6:19-20).

This month we observed the 80th anniversary of the attack on the Pearl Harbor Naval Base. This event has become one of the transformative events for Americans who have vowed never again to be taken by surprise by an enemy dedicated to our destruction. America lost its innocence that day resulting in a dramatic change to our position on the world stage. We realized that global politics coupled with military technology no longer made us safe behind our two oceans. We also came to understand that we cannot ignore the forces of evil at work in the world. While we diligently seek peace our nation

must be ready to meet those who would seek to do us harm. Pearl Harbor transformed an illequipped, fledgling military into a superior global reaching deterrent force.

Addressing the spiritual needs of our Servicemen and women is essential for their well-being and their ability to successfully complete their missions. This is why the AMEN Military Ministry was created to help military Christians connect with the local body of Christ and grow in faith and love with Jesus. For 46 years AMEN

sought to Build the Love of God in the Heart of the Warrior. The need remains as critical today as it did in 1976 but the means for building spiritual resilience means adapting to today's environment. The arrival of the internet, the demands of the COVID 19 pandemic, and the

nuances of the post-millennial generation requires seeing this ministry with fresh eyes. The Locator Service with its connections to the local church remains a vital aspect of the AMEN ministry. But our Key Men and Women can play an even greater role as facilitators providing for deeper spiritual growth. AMEN is collaborating with God's Word For Warriors to offer five unique programs for our warfighters. These include Faith & Transition; Faith & Military Culture; Boots to Business; Course Leader Training; and Operation Female Warrior. These courses can be a powerful outreach to the local military community transforming military ministry in 2022.

IN MEMORIUM


