From my personal experience I was led to Christ by Christians serving at Karamursel Turkey through the home Bible studies and fellowship we enjoyed daily. It was the finest experience of hospitality that created the spirit of family, so important to those us stationed 5,000 miles from home.

Traveling around I hear other stories where lives have been impacted by Key Men and Women reaching out to younger or new Christians recently arrived at their duty station. To this day Cold War veterans have told me how much AMEN helped them during their active-duty days. I've seen it in the faces of young recruits in Basic Training at Fort Jackson or Fort Sill who rely upon mature Christians for the worship services which bring a bit of respite to the stresses of boot camp. Lifelong friendships and wonderful memories have been made through the relationships built among Key Men and Women and military Christians.
